

JAYS CARE FOUNDATION 50/50 DRAW PROGRAM

The Jays Care Foundation is pleased to offer registered charities the opportunity to participate in the 50-50 Draws at Rogers Centre during the 2008 baseball season.

The 50/50 Draws will take place at each Friday, Saturday and Sunday home game, as well as Monday, August 4th (Civic Holiday) and the final home game of the year on Thursday, September 25th.

Tickets prices will be 3 for \$5.00 or 7 for \$10.00. The maximum jackpot has been raised to just under \$10,000 for each draw, meaning organizations can raise as much as almost \$5,000 this season!

Organizations will be responsible for ensuring that **at least 30 volunteers** will be present at each 50/50 Draw. One person must act as the Team Leader and will be responsible for all volunteers as well as helping to count the money once the Draw is complete. **Volunteers under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.**

Volunteers must **arrive at Gate 7 no less than 30 minutes prior to the gates opening** (gates open at 11:00 a.m. on weekends and 5:30 p.m. on Weekdays). **NEW FOR 2008, sellers are required to complete and submit the attached waiver. This waiver has been put in place to allow ticket sellers to be in the aisles PRE-GAME ONLY.**

Team Leaders must submit the names of volunteers at least 48 hours in advance of the 50-50 Draw. **Only names on this list will be allowed entry into the stadium.**

Upon arrival, volunteers will be given security credentials, t-shirts, aprons and a cash float. Volunteers will be required to sell tickets from the time the gates open to the bottom of the 3rd inning. Once completed, they will then be given a ticket to watch the remainder of the game.

The participating organization will be sent a cheque within 30 (thirty) days of their involvement with the raffle.

If the fundraising organization is unable to provide sufficient volunteers or needs to cancel, I must be contacted a minimum of 5 business days prior to the scheduled draw.
